PROJECT PROPSAL

- Scheme** - In order to provide all weather connectivity for revenue villages "Chief Minister Rural Road Scheme" (CMGSY) was launched in the year 2010 in the state of Madhya Pradesh. CMGSY envisages connecting all habitations having population less than 500 in plains and less than 250 in tribal areas as per the census of 2001
- Progress** - As of now 8218 habitations has been connected and 18549.10 Kms length of all-weather roads have been completed.
- Project** - About 1607 habitations notified as revenue village after the census of 2001 and are still un-connected. Approximately 3704.40 Kms length of roads required to be constructed for connecting the left out habitations.

IMPACT

Long term impacts of this project will be reduction in poverty, improvement of rural area accessibility and overall economic growth of rural population.

Immediate project outcome will be improved and more sustainable connectivity in the state.

IMPLEMENTATION AND FINANCIAL PLANNING
